What is a **Short Code?**

A five- to six-digit phone number that allows businesses to send mass text messages.



No More Shared Short Codes





In June 2021, shared short codes became obsolete.

The Issue?



The same short codes were shared by multiple companies



They allowed only one-way text transmission, and carriers often blocked them as spam



Numbers shared across unrelated companies put brand reputation at risk



Problem Solved

Businesses who want to send mass text messages should use a dedicated short code.


